

Jim Gilmour Band and Friends Tour Bonaire
-- *“Not your daddy’s folk music”*

Vermont, USA resident, Jim Gilmour, folk musician, singer, songwriter and sound engineer returns to Bonaire for the fifth time to visit family and entertain the residents of our sunny Island. But this year his visit is a bit different. Jim brings with him his entire band and their families to share in the joys of Bonairean life and activities.

The 5-man group, featuring Jim on vocals and acoustic guitar, also includes Ryan Dubois on bass, Paul Carroccio, drums, Charlie Rockwell, keyboard, and Jeff Poremski, guitar and vocals.

The Jim Gilmour Band will make five Bonaire appearances together during their stay and will feature several local musicians and singers Jim has befriended over the last four years as well.

Band family members will have plenty of time to enjoy our beautiful reefs, waters and outdoor activities, while band members, themselves, have reserved only one day for relaxation and enjoyment of our Island ambience. The rest of their time will be spent performing and rehearsing at various venues together and with several local musicians.

The busy week begins with a “happy hour” and Tex-Mex dinner performance at the Sorobon Beach Resort on Saturday, April 14, 5-9 p.m. On Sunday the 15th, they will perform a “Lazy Sunday,” also at Sorobon Beach, with a few sets of acoustic music from 1 to 4 p.m.

On Monday the 16th, the band and families will be treated to a dinner by the Club Roomer Charitable Organization for whom they have provided three years of fund-raising efforts to help Bonairean men, women and children in need.

The busy schedule continues with “Quirky Songs & Grill Night” by The Dubois and acoustic performances by the Gilmour Band on Tuesday, April 17th for a special barbeque at Sorobon, then an open rehearsal for local musicians and singers on Wednesday, April 18, with the Band at Hotel Roomer in Belnem. Here, from 5 till 7 p.m. for and “Happy Hour Jam” the Band and local musicians and singers, including Terence de Haseth on guitar, Jasper Blokzijl, keyboard, Gaby Mercera, drums and budding local vocalist, Farah Cecilia will rehearse for Friday’s finale event.

The Band’s final performance, with special island guests, will take place at Hotel Roomer from 6 to 10 p.m. on Friday evening, April 20. The “Club Roomer Charity Donation Event” will be the grand finale of appearances of the Jim Gilmour Band and Friends this season.
